Water Operator Jon Rabus will work on a draft and get it to the attorney for correction. **USDA LOAN STATUS:** The BoD was presented with funding options laid out for us by Element Engineering. <u>Option one</u>, including 3<sup>rd</sup> filing with a loan of \$4.5 million and a grant of \$3.7 million. No money from ARWP up front for funding. <u>Option two</u>, reducing both the loan and grant amount and not including work in the 3<sup>rd</sup> filing. The BoD was made aware that these numbers were not to the penny, but rough numbers used for the purpose of making a funding choice. Details would follow from USDA at the appropriate time.

A motion was made by Deb Carpenter to proceed with the USDA Loan application pursuing Option 1 and request that the funding package move forward to National Office. No current loan refinance condition unless necessary. This motion was seconded by Esta Langlais. This motion passed.
